The work is physically demanding, so you will need to be able bodied and reasonably fit and healthy. We have found that a basic mechanical aptitude is essential, along with some electrical knowledge and experience operating programmable electronic systems.

All our work is project based and we schedule contract labour as required for each of the larger jobs. Although general experience in the AV industry is necessary to setup any job, we also require show operators who have more specialised experience and training in particular pieces of equipment such as digital sound desks or lighting controllers.

A current Police check, while not essential, is desirable as we do a lot of work for schools.

It is an advantage if you are setup as a "Sole Trader" with your own ABN, Public Liability Insurance and vehicle. If you can afford it, you will find that a commercial van is invaluable for carting gear in a safe and secure manner and will give you a big advantage in picking up more contract work in the industry.
